GREATER ACCESS TO WORLD TOP UNIVERSITIES

The Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) is an internationally recognized education credential offering students with unique competitiveness and fewer barriers in their university application and admission to top world universities in Canada, the United States, the United Kingdom, Australia, Singapore, and Hong Kong, China.

UNITED STATES



The SAT is not required for OSSD applicants for many of universities in the U.S., which allows for students to focus on achieving a high GPA during their grade 11/12 years. Students only need six grade 12 unniversity level courses to meet all academic requirements when applying to unniversities in the U.S.

CANADA *

With an OSSD, students can apply to universities in Canada as a local Ontario high school student, which grants a much higher acceptance rate in competitive university programs

UNITED KINGDOM



A-Level tests or pre-programs are not required for OSSD applicants. Students only need six grade 12 university level courses to meet all academic requirements when applying to universities in the UK.

AUSTRALIA



A level tests or pre-programs are not required for OSSD applicants. Students only need six grade 12 university level courses to meet all academic requirements when applying to universities in Australia.

SINGAPORE



The required for IELTS/TOEFL scores is waived for OSSD students if they achieve more than 80% in the grade 12 english course. Students only need six grade 12 university level courses to meet all academic requirements when applying to universities in Singapore.

HONG KONG, CHINA



The requirements for IELTS/TOEFL scores is waived for OSSD students if they achieve more than 80% in the grade 12 english course. Students only need six grade 12 university level courses to meet all academic requirements when applying to universities in Hong Kong.
